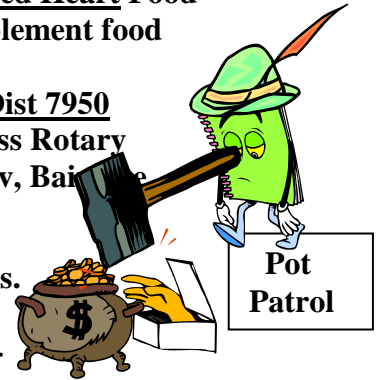

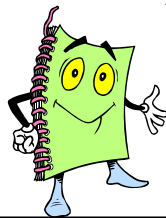
A message from Shirley: BRAVO! -

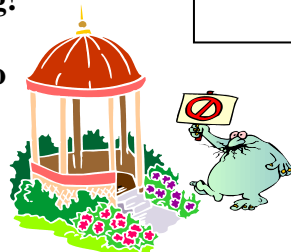
