This was a business meeting. Emphasis was placed on recruiting new members to the club.

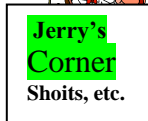
Phil Brillante's Safety Tip –

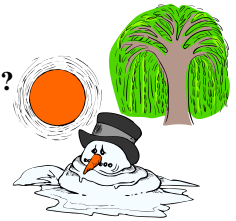
More brags next week!
