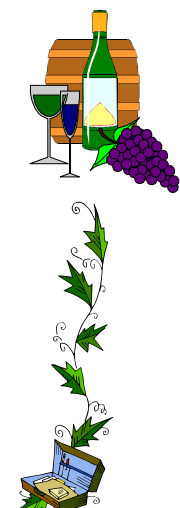
Phil Brillante's Safety Tip –
