

Last Weeks Program – Gary Ferguson , the Bannerman Island Trust, re: The History & the Restoration project: “The Algonquin Indians”, native Americans, were the original owners of the island, later known as Pollepel Island. American entrepreneur Francis Bannerman a Scotsman, acquired the Island, and between 1901 & 1918 he built a Scottish Castle on the Isle. It became a munitions storage facility, where weaponry & munitions from various armies throughout the world were stored. It fell into ruin over the years, but is presently being restored.
