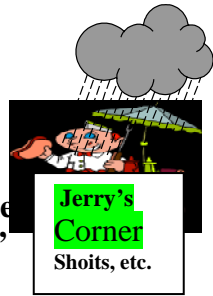

by protestors!



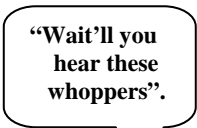
Phil Brillante's Safety Tip!

“Pennies from Heaven!”)

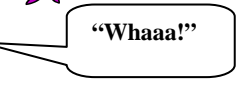
