Phil Brillante's Safety Tip!

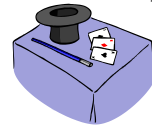
Once again Phil offered words of wisdom when tending to outdoor projects, i.e. lawn care, etc. remove all hazardous items on ground and wear safety equipment.

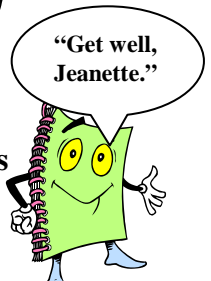
