Will Plumly - Attended two sessions of O/C Leadership (Gov't politics) – how things work. It included the concept of Home Rule.

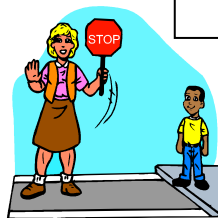
